Fizzy Cloud Dough	
1	 <p>Mix flour, baking soda, and vegetable oil to make the cloud dough.</p>
2	 <p>Add gel food coloring to color the dough if wanted.</p>
3	 <p>Use spray bottles or eye droppers to spray vinegar into the mixture and watch it fizzle!</p>
4	 <p>Play</p>





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
