


Matter

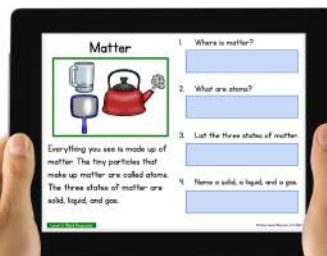
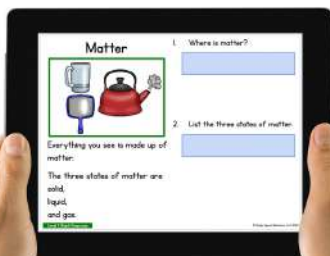
Age-appropriate on level curriculum is critical in a Special Ed classroom.
